Tadamon Crowdfunding Academy is an interactive training program that empowers and builds capacities to help organizations gain the necessary knowledge and skills on how to prepare and run a successful crowdfunding campaign. This program is intended for you, Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) that want to start, expand, or rebuild their programs or social business using online tools and innovative technologies. Through interactive online modules and tools, organizations will learn how to create and run elements of crowdfunding campaigns to mobilize the community, gather funds, and improve their presence so that they will be able in the end to launch their crowdfunding campaign.

As a civil society organization participating in the Tadamon Crowdfunding Academy, you will have a chance to work with top crowdfunding experts from around the world. Our focus is interaction: organizations will get an opportunity to receive guidance and feedback from our mentors. If you follow the course closely and work hard, you will develop all the necessary crowdfunding elements such as communication strategy, visual and textual elements, and rewards to successfully launch your crowdfunding campaign by the end of this course.

STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAM

The Tadamon Crowdfunding Academy modules are tailored to fit your needs and improve your skills to launch your own successful crowdfunding campaign. Each module contains the following elements:

- a video
- a presentation
- supporting materials
- a quiz

Modules 3, 6, 9, and 12 contain mandatory assignments. They are not only meant to test your knowledge: by submitting them you are also creating elements of your crowdfunding campaign. Once you complete all the assignments, you should be almost ready to launch your own campaign! Whenever you upload an assignment, you will get feedback from your mentor.

After you complete all modules and submit the final assignment, you will earn your course completion certificate. The final assignment is the final draft of your crowdfunding campaign, and needs to be approved by the mentor. Don't worry, we will make it easy for you. Just follow the steps below to complete the course.

- Submit quality assignments by following the deadline set up by your mentor (code)

- Communicate with your mentor and your CFA community
- due to family, health or work issues, please inform us as early as possible
- Listen and respond to feedback

MENTORING

After completing the Tadamon Crowdfunding Academy course on the Kaya platform, you should launch your crowdfunding campaign, maximum within 3-5 months. During the implementation of your crowdfunding campaign, your mentor will be available for one-on-one sessions to answer questions and offer guidance. It is best for each team to arrange the schedule with their mentor before launching the campaign.
