Creating a campaign related to forest conservation targeting young people, presented according to their interests.

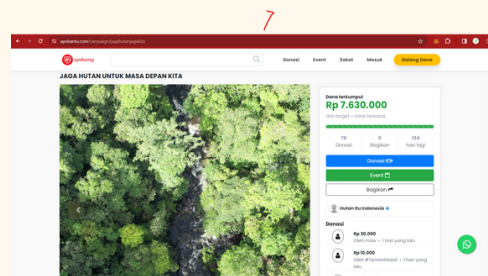
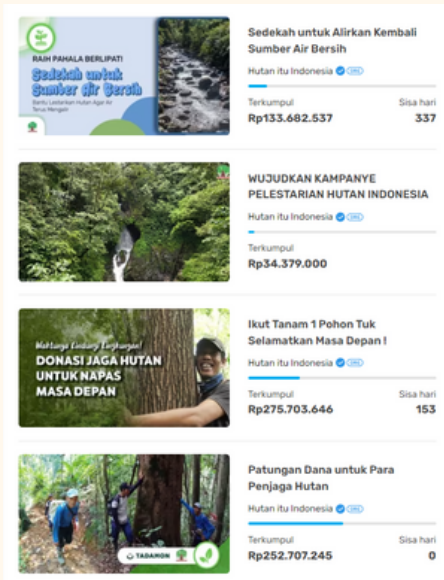
Climate Action

Trees were adopted from 18 forest areas including conservation and restoration of mangrove forests and tropical forests.

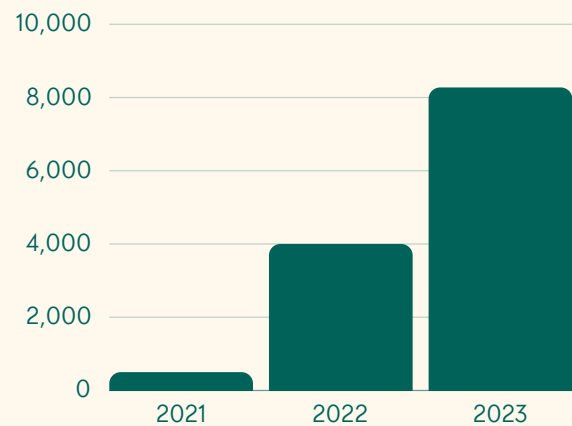
