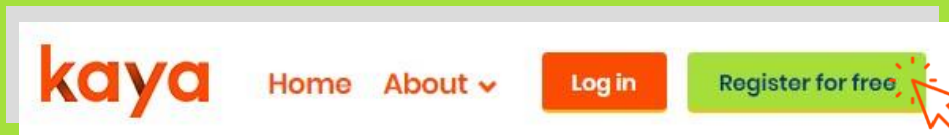
The Tadamon Capacity Strengthening Hub is the product of a partnership with The Humanitarian Leadership Academy, the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) and the Islamic Solidarity Fund for Development (ISFD) to provide organisations participating in the Tadamon programme with resources to support their learning and capacity strengthening needs.

Kaya hosts the Tadamon Capacity Strengthening Hub and is a global learning platform designed to be accessed from Phones, tablets, laptops and PCs so you can use it whenever and wherever you are. This guide provides everything you need to know as a learner.

Create an account

To access the Hub, track your progress and download your badges, you will need to create a **free** account at [Kayaconnect.org](https://kayaconnect.org).


Click the **Register for free** button at the top of the page, or from the main menu if you are using a mobile.



On the registration page you will be asked to complete the mandatory fields that are marked with an asterisk, including your email address, name and other basic information.

Once you have completed all the fields you should select **Create my new account** at the bottom of the page.

When your account is created you are automatically sent an email with a link that you must click in order to **confirm your account**. You can't join courses until you've done this.

Sometimes the confirmation email can get stuck in your junk folder, or is stopped before it even reaches your computer. If you think this has happened to you then click **Need help?** at the bottom of any page on Kaya to speak to one of our support technicians who will be able to manually confirm your account for you.

You can edit your profile information at any point after registration by clicking on your name at the top of the screen and then selecting **Profile** then **Edit profile**.

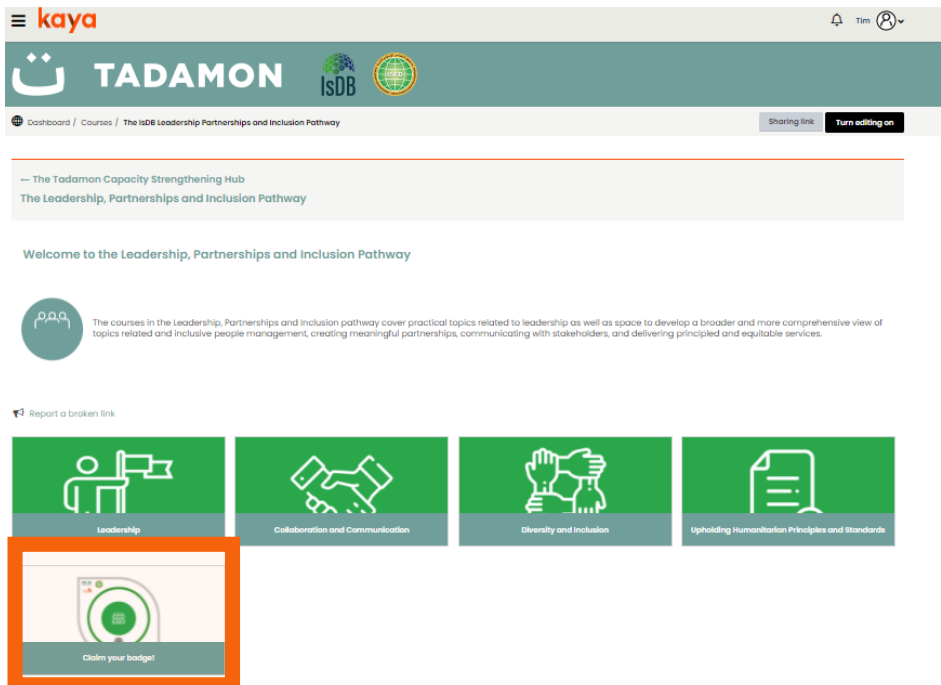

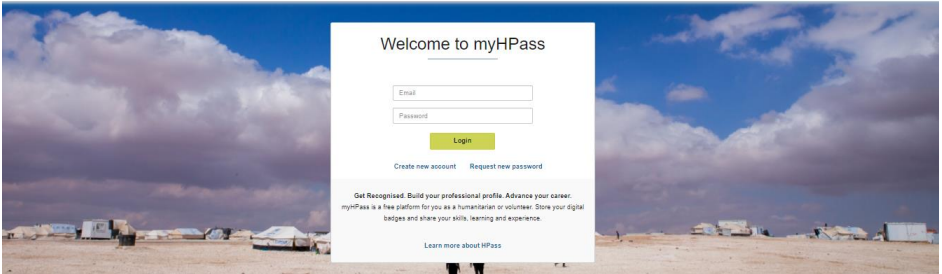

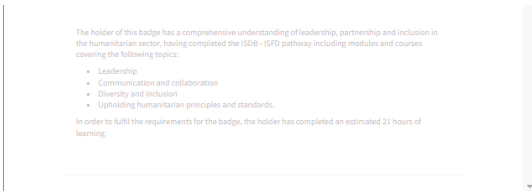
